# Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 **SECTION 1.** Section 27-104-301, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9 amended as follows:

10 27-104-301. (1) A special fund, to be designated the "2018 11 Transportation and Infrastructure Improvements Fund," is created 12 within the State Treasury, which shall consist of funds made 13 available by the Legislature in any manner and funds from any 14 other source designated for deposit into such fund. The fund 15 shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as a separate and 16 special fund, separate and apart from the General Fund of the 17 state. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a

18 fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any 19 interest earned or investment earnings on amounts in the fund 20 shall be deposited into such fund.
