Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the University of Mississippi Medical
9	Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and ending
10	June 30, 2021\$ 163,027,592.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
12	may be necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for
13	expenditure out of the proceeds derived from patient fees, student
14	fees or any other special source funds which are collected by or



16	University of Mississippi Medical Center for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021
18	\$ 1,539,328,475.00.
19	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated and authorized for
20	expenditure under the provisions of Section 1 and Section 2, the
21	University of Mississippi Medical Center shall maintain the School
22	of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the School of Nursing, the
23	School of Health Related Professions, the School of Population
24	Health, the Teaching Hospital and the Medical Center Service Area.
25	The University of Mississippi Medical Center shall prepare and
26	make available to the Legislature an accounting of expenditures
27	for each of the divisions listed in this section at the beginning
28	of the legislative session.
29	SECTION 4. Due to critical nurse shortages and staffing, it
30	is the intention of the Legislature to enhance recognition of
31	excellence and expand the experience factor in attracting
32	qualified registered nurses.
33	SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, and the
34	funds authorized to be expended in Section 2, none may be used to
35	provide medical services on behalf of any state agency,
36	institution or political subdivision, except to the extent that

otherwise become available, for the support and maintenance of the

such agency, institution or political subdivision reimburses the

rendering of medical services to any such agency, institution or

hospital for the cost of the services provided. Upon the

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- 40 political subdivision, the hospital shall issue an invoice for the
- 41 charges which shall be paid within ninety (90) days. In the event
- 42 that payment is not made within ninety (90) days, the hospital
- 43 shall discontinue providing services to that agency, institution
- 44 or political subdivision until all outstanding charges have been
- 45 paid.
- 46 **SECTION 6.** Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and
- 47 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be
- 48 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of
- 49 Mississippi and Section 25-4-105, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 50 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 51 University of Mississippi Medical Center's budget request for
- 52 Fiscal Year 2022 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
- 53 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
- 54 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2021
- 55 budget request process.
- 56 **SECTION 8.** Of the funds authorized for expenditure in
- 57 Section 2, Six Million Eight Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand
- 58 Twenty-nine Dollars (\$6,888,029.00) shall be derived from the
- 59 Education Enhancement Fund from funds deposited pursuant to
- 60 Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 61 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 62 Section 2, Two Million Three Hundred Eighty Thousand Four Hundred
- 63 Thirty-one Dollars (\$2,380,431.00) shall be derived from the
- 64 Health Care Expendable Fund created in Section 43-13-407,



- 65 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and maintenance of the
- 66 University of Mississippi Medical Center.
- 67 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 68 of Section 1, the sum of Three Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars
- 69 (\$315,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships for the Rural
- 70 Dentists Scholarship Program as described in House Bill 776, 2013
- 71 Regular Session.
- 72 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 73 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 74 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 75 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 76 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 77 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 78 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 79 made without competitive bids.
- 80 **SECTION 12.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
- 81 Section 2, One Million Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars
- 82 (\$1,830,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships for the Rural
- 83 Physicians' Scholarship Program as described in House Bill 1465,
- 84 2007 Regular Session. Of this amount, Thirty Thousand Dollars
- 85 (\$30,000.00) is provided for a Psychiatrist Scholarship as
- 86 described in Senate Bill 2524, 2019 Regular Session.
- 87 **SECTION 13.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the sum
- of Four Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$4,250,000.00)



- 89 is hereby appropriated for the University of Mississippi Medical
- 90 Center Cancer Institute.
- 91 **SECTION 14.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Five
- 92 Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$595,000.00) is hereby
- 93 appropriated for a Comprehensive Tobacco Center at the University
- 94 of Mississippi Medical Center.
- 95 **SECTION 15.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One
- 96 Million Four Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$1,425,000.00)
- 97 is provided for the Office of Mississippi Physician Workforce as
- 98 described in House Bill 317, 2012 Regular Session.
- 99 **SECTION 16.** None of the funds appropriated and/or authorized
- 100 for expenditure under this act shall be used for research that
- 101 kills or destroys an existing human embryo.
- 102 **SECTION 17.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 103 of Section 1, One Million Three Hundred Ninety-one Thousand Seven
- 104 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,391,750.00) shall be provided from
- 105 General Funds and shall be provided to the Center of Excellence at
- 106 the Blair E. Batson Hospital for Children for the care of abused
- 107 and neglected children, and expended to improve, enlarge and/or
- 108 construct the physical facilities of the Children's Safe Center
- 109 and for support and maintenance of the center.
- 110 **SECTION 18.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 111 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 112 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 113 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their



- 114 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 115 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 116 actions contrary to this provision.
- 117 **SECTION 19.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
- 118 Section 2 of this act, Two Hundred Eighty-nine Thousand Five
- 119 Hundred Thirty-four Dollars (\$289,534.00) is provided for the
- 120 administration of the Rural Physicians' Scholarship Program and
- 121 the Rural Dentists' Scholarship Program.
- 122 **SECTION 20.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- of Section 1, Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) shall be
- 124 provided to the MIND Center at the University of Mississippi
- 125 Medical Center.
- 126 **SECTION 21.** It is the intention of the Legislature that any
- 127 cash balances at the Office of Physician Workforce, the Children's
- 128 Safe Center, and the MIND Center shall only be spent in support of
- 129 those divisions.
- 130 **SECTION 22.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 131 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 132 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 133 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 134 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 135 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 136 **SECTION 23.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 137 and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 138 June 30, 2020.
