Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 14 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 15 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available

- 20 **SECTION 3.** Any transfer shall be made in accordance with the
- 21 terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 23 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 24 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 25 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 26 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 27 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2022 shall be submitted to
- 28 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 29 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 30 during the Fiscal Year 2021 budget request process.
- 31 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Five
- 32 Hundred Fifty-two Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty Dollars
- 33 (\$552,920.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund
- 34 from funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31,
- 35 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 36 **SECTION 6.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 37 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
- 38 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
- 39 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
- 40 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,

82	SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
83	act, the amount of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars
84	(\$125,000.00) shall be used for the purpose of testing,
85	programming, and personnel related expenses for Chronic Waste
86	Disease.
87	SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that
88	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
89	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
90	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

- 91 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 92 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 93 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 94 made without competitive bids.
- 95 **SECTION 9.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 96 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 97 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 98 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 99 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 100 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 101 actions contrary to this provision.
- 102 **SECTION 10.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 103 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 104 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 105 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 106 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 107 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 108 **SECTION 11.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 109 and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 110 June 30, 2020.
