Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 20 this act, the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 21 22 Full Time.... 2 Permanent: 23 Part Time.... 1 24 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 0 25 Part Time.... 0 26 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 27 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law. 28 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 29 30 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 31 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 32 SECTION 4. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 33 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of 34 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 35 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for 36 any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 37 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

20/HR13/SB2948A.J PAGE 2 (LAR/DW) 38 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 39 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972. 40 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 41 42 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 43 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 44 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 45 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 46 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 47 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 48 made without competitive bids.

49 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 50 Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway Development Authority shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the 51 52 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 53 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 54 maintained for Fiscal Year 2020. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 55 56 2022 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 57 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 58 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2021 budget request 59 process.

60 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 61 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 62 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency

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63 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 64 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 65 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 66 actions contrary to this provision.

67 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 68 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 69 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 70 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 71 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 72 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

73 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 74 and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed from and after 75 June 30, 2020.
