Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill No. 2961

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Public
8	Accountancy, for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred by
9	said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and ending
10	June 30, 2021\$ 640,563.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12	this act, the following positions are authorized:
13	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
14	Permanent: Full Time

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With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 18 19 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be 20 appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2022 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2021 funds appropriated for that purpose, 21 22 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 23 2021 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data 24 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel 25 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to 26 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the 27 28 agency head to ensure that no single personnel action increases 29 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2021 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the 30 31 exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 32 33 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 34 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 35 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2021 "Personal Services" 36 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 37 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 38 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 39

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40 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 41 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 42 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 43 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 44 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 45 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 46 47 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 48 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

57 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that 58 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 59 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 60 61 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 62 63 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 64

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65 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 66 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 67 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 68 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 69 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 70 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 71 actions contrary to this provision.

72 The money herein appropriated shall be paid by SECTION 5. 73 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 74 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 75 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 76 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 77 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 78 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 79 and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed from and after 80 June 30, 2020.

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
