64	SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
65	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
66	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable
67	College Tuition Trust Fund for the purpose of paying all amounts
68	due for prepaid tuition contracts of the Mississippi Prepaid
69	Affordable College Tuition Program, for the fiscal year beginning
70	July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021\$ 35,000,000.00.
71	It is the intention of the Legislature that the State
72	Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend an
73	amount not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from any
74	funds authorized for the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College
75	Tuition Program, for paying amounts due for prepaid tuition
76	contracts of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition
77	Program. Such funds shall be escalated in accordance with the
78	rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
79	Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of

81	SECTION 5. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be
82	used in the payment of attorney's fees, nor shall any of said
83	funds be used either directly or indirectly, for the purpose of

 provided that when the relationship is by affinity and the person
 through whom the relationship was established is dead, this
 - SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Office of the State Treasurer shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of details as maintained for Fiscal Year 2020. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2022 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2021 budget request process.
 - SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

131	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
132	proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
