

Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1279

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

30 SECTION 1. (1) The segment of U.S. Highway 51 in Lincoln
31 County, Mississippi, beginning at its intersection at Natchez
32 Avenue and extending north to its intersection with Brookway
33 Boulevard is designated as the "Corporal Zach Moak and Officer
34 James White Memorial Highway."

35 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
36 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
37 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

38 SECTION 2. (1) The segment of Mississippi Highway 589 in
39 Lamar County, Mississippi, beginning one-half (1/2) mile north of
40 its intersection with Victory Road and extending one (1) mile
41 south, is designated as the "Benjamin J. Deen Memorial Highway."

42 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
43 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
44 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

45 SECTION 3. (1) The segment of Mississippi Highway 50 in
46 Lowndes County, Mississippi, in the corporate limits of the City

47 of Columbus, Mississippi, beginning at its intersection with
48 Gardner Boulevard and extending one (1) mile east, is designated
49 as the "Senator William 'Bill' Canon Memorial Highway."

50 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
51 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
52 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

53 **SECTION 4.** (1) The segment of U.S. Highway 11 in Jones
54 County, Mississippi, beginning at its intersection with Hill
55 Street and extending one (1) mile south, is designated as the
56 "Coach Elmer Higginbotham Memorial Highway."

57 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
58 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
59 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

60 **SECTION 5.** (1) The segment of U.S. Highway 45 in Alcorn
61 County and Prentiss County, Mississippi, beginning one (1) mile
62 north of the intersection of U.S. Highway 45 and Mississippi
63 Highway 356 and ending two (2) miles south of the intersection of
64 U.S. Highway 45 and Mississippi Highway 356, is designated as the
65 "Speaker William J. 'Billy' McCoy Memorial Highway."

66 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
67 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
68 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

69 **SECTION 6.** (1) The segment of Mississippi Highway 35 in
70 Jefferson Davis County, Mississippi, beginning at the northern
71 corporate limits of the Town of Bassfield and extending south for
72 one (1) mile, is designated as the "H.D. Broome Memorial Highway."

73 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
74 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
75 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

76 **SECTION 7.** (1) The segment of Mississippi Highway 371 in
77 Itawamba County, Mississippi, beginning one-half (1/2) mile north
78 of its intersection with Ozark Baptist Church Road and extending
79 south to a point one-half (1/2) mile south of its intersection
80 with Ozark Baptist Church Road, is designated as the "Jeff Boren
81 Memorial Highway."

82 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
83 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
84 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

85 **SECTION 8.** (1) The segment of Mississippi Highway 16 in
86 Leake County, Mississippi, in the corporate limits of the City of
87 Carthage, Mississippi, beginning at its intersection with Dona
88 Drive and extending west to 1300 Highway 16, is designated as the
89 "Blake Burgess Memorial Highway."

90 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
91 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
92 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

93 **SECTION 9.** (1) The segment of Mississippi Highway 42 in
94 Greene County, Mississippi, beginning at its southern intersection
95 with Mississippi Highway 63 and extending one (1) mile west, is
96 designated as the "Piney Woods Creek Memorial Highway in
97 Recognition EOW April 1, 1921, Deputy U.S. Marshal Jake Green and
98 Greene County Deputy Lawrence Dunnam."

99 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect
100 and maintain appropriate signs along and approaching the segment
101 of highway described in subsection (1) of this section.

102 **SECTION 10.** (1) On Mississippi Highway 25 in Rankin County,
103 Mississippi, where the Pisgah and Ross Barnett Reservoir signs are
104 located near the Pisgah exit may be erected a sign or signs that
105 reads as follows: "Home of Tori Bowie, Olympic Gold Medalist,
106 Pisgah High School Graduate."

107 (2) The sign or signs described in subsection (1) of this
108 section are to be erected in accordance with the Mississippi
109 Department of Transportation's permitting process and must be paid
110 for by Rankin County.

111 **SECTION 11.** For the purpose of directing motorists to the
112 Lynyrd Skynyrd Monument in Pike County, Mississippi, the
113 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain
114 appropriate signs along certain highway segments approaching the
115 monument as follows:

116 (a) At Exit 8 of Interstate 55, on both the northbound
117 and the southbound sides, to indicate the turn onto Mississippi
118 Highway 568; and

119 (b) On Mississippi Highway 568 to indicate the turn
120 onto Easley Road.

121 **SECTION 12.** Section 11 of this act shall be codified in
122 Title 65, Chapter 3, Mississippi Code of 1972.

123 **SECTION 13.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
124 and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2020.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9 IN JONES COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS THE "COACH ELMER HIGGINBOTHAM
10 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF U.S. HIGHWAY 45 IN
11 ALCORN COUNTY AND PRENTISS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS THE "SPEAKER
12 WILLIAM J. 'BILLY' MCCOY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT
13 OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 35 IN JEFFERSON DAVIS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI,
14 AS THE "H.D. BROOME MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF
15 MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 371 IN ITAWAMBA COUNTY AS THE "JEFF BOREN
16 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY
17 16 IN LEAKE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS THE "BLAKE BURGESS MEMORIAL
18 HIGHWAY"; TO DESIGNATE A SEGMENT OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 42 IN
19 GREENE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, AS THE "PINEY WOODS CREEK MEMORIAL
20 HIGHWAY IN RECOGNITION EOW APRIL 1, 1921, DEPUTY U.S. MARSHAL JAKE
21 GREEN AND GREENE COUNTY DEPUTY LAWRENCE DUNNAM"; TO AUTHORIZE A
22 SIGN OR SIGNS TO BE ERECTED ON MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 25 IN RANKIN
23 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO HONOR OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALIST TORI BOWIE; TO
24 CREATE A NEW SECTION IN TITLE 65, CHAPTER 3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF
25 1972, TO REQUIRE THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO
26 ERECT SIGNS ON INTERSTATE 55 AND MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY 568 DIRECTING
27 MOTORISTS TO THE LYNYRD SKYNYRD MONUMENT IN PIKE COUNTY,
28 MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
