Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1718

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Registered Foresters 8 9 Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Board 10 of Registration for Foresters for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021.....\$ 11 39,050.00. 12 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 13 State Board of Registration for Foresters shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 14 15 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 16 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 17 Year 2020. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 18 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2022 shall be 19 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 20 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2021 budget request process. 21

22 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that

23 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

- 24 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 25 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 26 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 27 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 28 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 29 made without competitive bids.
- 30 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 31 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 32 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 33 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 34 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 35 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 36 actions contrary to this provision.
- 37 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 38 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 39 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 40 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 41 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 42 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 43 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2020.
