Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1723

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any
7	funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the
8	Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses of the authority for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2021
11	\$ 59,998,047.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
15	Permanent: Full Time
16	Part Time
17	Time-Limited: Full Time
18	Part Time
19	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
20	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

H. B. 1723 PAGE 1 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

25 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 26 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall maintain 27 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 28 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 29 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 30 maintained for Fiscal Year 2020. It is further the intention of 31 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 32 2022 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 33 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2021 budget request 34 35 process.

36 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 37 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 38 39 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 40 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 41 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 42 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 43 made without competitive bids.

44 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated herein, One Hundred 45 Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$135,000.00) is provided for salary

H. B. 1723 PAGE 2 46 increase for the purpose of funding overtime, callback or standby 47 pay.

48 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 49 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 50 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 51 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 52 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 53 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 54 actions contrary to this provision.

55 SECTION 7. The money appropriated under the provisions of 56 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper 57 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

58 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 59 and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2020.
