L15	Mississippi Real Estate Commission and the Real Estate Appraiser
L16	Licensing and Certification Board shall maintain complete
L17	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
L18	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
L19	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
L20	Year 2020. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
L21	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2022 shall be
L22	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
L23	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
L24	provided during the Fiscal Year 2021 budget request process.
L25	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that
L26	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
L27	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
L28	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
29	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
L30	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
L31	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
L32	made without competitive bids.
L33	SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
L34	funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
L35	Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
L36	shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their

appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally

- or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.
- section 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
  the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
  credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
  warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
  Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
  proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2020, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2020.
