AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

**Cmte Sub for Senate Bill No. 2545**

1           **AMEND by inserting the following section after line 494 and**  
2 **renumbering:**

3           **SECTION \*.** Section 67-1-52, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
4 amended as follows:

5           67-1-52. A package retailer's permit issued under Section  
6 67-1-51(b) shall \* \* \* be authorized to offer tastings\_ or  
7 samplings\_ \* \* \* to be conducted at the package retailer's  
8 permitted place of business during which tastes or samples of  
9 alcoholic beverages or wine may be offered or served to consumers  
10 at no cost to the consumer. During a tasting or sampling \* \* \*  
11 authorized by this section, limited amounts of alcoholic beverages  
12 or wine may be consumed on the permitted place of business. A  
13 tasting or sampling \* \* \* shall not authorize the sale of  
14 alcoholic beverages or wine for consumption on the permitted place



15 of business, but shall only authorize the limited consumption of  
16 alcoholic beverages or wine at the permitted place of business for  
17 the sole purpose of tasting or sampling various alcoholic  
18 beverages or wine. \* \* \* No one under twenty-one (21) years of  
19 age may participate in a tasting or sampling \* \* \*. No sample may  
20 be provided to a visibly intoxicated person. No food may be  
21 served or sold at a tasting or sampling \* \* \*. Each sample of  
22 wine served \* \* \* shall not exceed one and one-fourth (1-1/4)  
23 ounces and no more than a cumulative total of five (5) ounces of  
24 wine may be dispensed to any one (1) person during a tasting or  
25 sampling \* \* \*. Each sample of a distilled spirit served \* \* \*  
26 shall not exceed one-fourth (1/4) of an ounce and no more than a  
27 cumulative total of one (1) ounce of distilled spirits may be  
28 dispensed to any one (1) person during a tasting or  
29 sampling \* \* \*. All product tasted or sampled \* \* \* must be  
30 provided by the package retailer from its inventory. Such product  
31 cannot be sample product provided by a manufacturer and must have  
32 been purchased from the department warehouse or from a licensed  
33 wholesaler. Only employees of the package retailer may serve any  
34 product for tasting or sampling \* \* \*. Tickets for a tasting or  
35 sampling \* \* \* shall not be sold in the permitted place of  
36 business or any other location. \* \* \*
