HOUSE BILL NO. 117

1 AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 41-37-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 2 1972, TO REQUIRE THAT ALL AUTOPSIES CONDUCTED IN THIS STATE 3 INCLUDE AN INQUIRY TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE DEATH WAS A DIRECT 4 RESULT OF A SEIZURE OR EPILEPSY; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE FINDINGS 5 IN AN AUTOPSY ARE CONSISTENT WITH KNOWN OR SUSPECTED SUDDEN UNEXPECTED DEATH IN EPILEPSY (SUDEP), THEN THE MEDICAL EXAMINER, 6 7 EXAMINING PHYSICIAN, OR CORONER SHALL CAUSE TO BE INDICATED ON THE DEATH CERTIFICATE THAT SUDEP IS THE CAUSE OR SUSPECTED CAUSE OF 8 9 DEATH, AND FORWARD A COPY OF THE DEATH CERTIFICATE TO THE NORTH 10 AMERICAN SUDEP REGISTRY WITHIN THIRTY DAYS; AND FOR RELATED 11 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 41-37-25, Mississippi Code of 1972:

15 <u>41-37-25.</u> (1) For the purposes of this section, the term 16 "sudden unexpected death in epilepsy" means a death in a patient 17 previously diagnosed with epilepsy that is not due to trauma, 18 drowning, status epilepticus, or other known causes, but for which 19 there is often evidence of an associated seizure. A finding of 20 sudden unexpected death in epilepsy is definite when clinical 21 criteria are met and autopsy reveals no alternative cause of 22 death, such as stroke, myocardial infarction or drug intoxication, 23 although there may be evidence of a seizure.

(2) All autopsies conducted in this state shall include an
inquiry to determine whether the death was a direct result of a
seizure or epilepsy. If the findings in an autopsy of a medical
examiner, examining physician, or coroner are consistent with
known or suspected sudden unexpected death in epilepsy (SUDEP),
then the medical examiner, examining physician, or coroner shall:

30 (a) Cause to be indicated on the death certificate that31 SUDEP is the cause or suspected cause of death; and

32 (b) Forward a copy of the death certificate to the
33 North American SUDEP Registry at the Langone Medical Center at New
34 York University within thirty (30) days.

35 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2021.
