- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 55-15-81, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 55-15-81. (1) None of the following items, structures or
- 12 areas may be relocated, removed, disturbed, altered, renamed or
- 13 rededicated, unless specifically authorized by an act of the
- 14 Legislature: * * * Statues, monuments, memorials or nameplates
- 15 (plaques), which have been erected on public property of the state
- 16 or any of its political subdivisions, such as local, municipal or
- 17 county owned public areas, and any statues, monuments, memorials,
- 18 nameplates (plagues), schools, streets, bridges, buildings, parks
- 19 preserves, reserves or other public items, structure or areas of
- 20 the state or any of its political subdivisions, such as, local,

- 21 municipal or county owned public areas, which has been dedicated
- 22 in memory of, or named for, any historical * * * figure, * * *
- 23 event, or * * * organization * * *.

- 25 (\star \star 2) This section shall not apply to items, structures
- or areas located on property owned or acquired by the Mississippi
- 27 Transportation Commission which may interfere with the
- 28 construction, maintenance or operation of public transportation
- 29 facilities.
- 30 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 31 and after its passage.
