HOUSE BILL NO. 178

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NATURAL RESOURCE CAMP PILOT PROGRAM
FOR STUDENTS IN LEE AND MONROE COUNTIES; TO PROVIDE THE PURPOSE OF
THE PROGRAM; TO PROVIDE THAT THE PROGRAM SHALL BE A THREE-YEAR
PROGRAM ADMINISTERED JOINTLY BY THE BOARDS OF SUPERVISORS OF LEE
AND MONROE COUNTIES; TO REQUIRE THE BOARDS TO SUBMIT AN ANNUAL
REPORT ON THE PROGRAM TO THE LEGISLATURE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE
PROGRAM IS SUBJECT TO RECEIVING FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THE
LEGISLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 **SECTION 1.** This act shall be known, and may be cited, as the
- 11 "Natural Resource Camp Pilot Program Act of 2021."
- 12 **SECTION 2.** (1) There is established for the students of Lee
- 13 and Monroe counties a Natural Resource Camp pilot program. The
- 14 program shall be for the purpose of teaching students the
- 15 importance of the soil, water, plants, animals and air; the need
- 16 to maintain a healthy environment; and the importance of land
- 17 ownership and the wealth that is obtained through owning property.
- 18 (2) The program shall be administered jointly by the boards
- 19 of supervisors of Lee and Monroe Counties.

- 20 (3) The program shall be implemented within sixty (60) days
- 21 after the effective date of this act and shall continue for three

- 23 the Legislature for that purpose, or funds received by the
- 24 counties as a gift, donation or bequest for such purposes.
- 25 **SECTION 3.** By July 1, 2022, and annually thereafter for the
- 26 duration of the pilot program, the boards of supervisors of Lee
- 27 and Monroe counties shall prepare and submit to the Legislature a
- 28 report of the data collected on the status of the program. The
- 29 report shall include:
- 30 (a) The number of students involved in the program;
- 31 (b) The number of staff required to implement and
- 32 operate the program;
- 33 (c) The cost of operating the program;
- 34 (d) An analysis of the effectiveness of the program;
- 35 (e) Recommendations to improve the program; and
- 36 (f) Projections as to the cost of implementing and
- 37 expanding the pilot program to a permanent program to meet the
- 38 needs of the entire state.
- 39 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 40 and after July 1, 2021.
