HOUSE BILL NO. 485

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A RIGHT OF FIRST REFUSAL IN REAL PROPERTY IS EXTINGUISHED UPON THE DEATH OF THE GRANTEE UNLESS THE INSTRUMENT GRANTING THE RIGHT CLEARLY STATES THAT UPON THE GRANTEE'S DEATH, IT SHALL INURE TO THE BENEFIT OF THE GRANTEE'S HEIRS AND ASSIGNS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** A right of first refusal in real property granted
- 8 through a contractual agreement or any other written instrument of
- 9 conveyance is extinguished upon the death of the grantee
- 10 right-holder unless the contractual agreement or instrument of
- 11 conveyance unambiguously states that upon the death of the grantee
- 12 right-holder, the right of first refusal shall be binding upon and
- 13 inure to the benefit of the heirs and assigns of the grantee
- 14 right-holder.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a new
- 16 section in Chapter 1, Title 89, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 17 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2021.

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
