HOUSE BILL NO. 488

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 39-3-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE PUBLIC LIBRARIES TO ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS, DEBIT CARDS AND OTHER FORMS OF ELECTRONIC PAYMENT; TO BRING FORWARD SECTION 39-3-369, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH RELATES TO DISCLOSING INFORMATION AND COLLECTING FINES FOR OVERDUE ITEMS, FOR THE PURPOSES OF POSSIBLE AMENDMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 39-3-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:

- 10 39-3-21. Except as otherwise provided for in this section,
- 11 every public library or public library system established or
- 12 maintained under this article shall be free for the use of the
- 13 residents of the territory included within the library service
- 14 area, subject to such reasonable rules and regulations as the
- 15 administrative board of trustees finds necessary. Reasonable
- 16 reimbursements may be collected for special library services,
- 17 provided these are determined in advance and in writing by the
- 18 administrative board of trustees.
- The board of trustees of any public library may allow the
- 20 payment of various fees and other accounts receivable to the

- 21 public library, by credit cards, charge cards, debit cards and
- 22 other forms of electronic payment, in accordance with policies
- 23 established by the State Auditor. Except as otherwise provided in
- 24 this section, any fees or charges associated with the use of such
- 25 electronic payments shall be assessed to the user of the
- 26 electronic payment as an additional charge for processing the
- 27 electronic payment, so that the user will pay the full cost of
- 28 using the electronic payment.
- 29 **SECTION 2.** Section 39-3-369, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 30 brought forward as follows:
- 31 39-3-369. No provision of this article shall be construed to
- 32 prohibit any library, or any business operating jointly with a
- 33 library, from disclosing information for the purpose of collecting
- 34 overdue books, documents, films or other items or materials owned
- 35 or otherwise belonging to such library. No provision of this
- 36 article shall be construed to prohibit or hinder any such library
- 37 or business office from collecting fines on such overdue books,
- 38 documents, films or other items or materials.
- 39 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 40 and after July 1, 2021.
