HOUSE BILL NO. 655

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-3-1215, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE PENALTY FOR ILLEGAL DRAG RACING TO MAKE IT A FELONY;
- 3 TO MAKE IT A FELONY TO WILLFULLY OBSTRUCT THE FLOW OF TRAFFIC BY
- 4 USE OR OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-3-1215, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 63-3-1215. (1) No person shall drive any vehicle upon the
- 9 public roads in this state in any race, speed competition or
- 10 contest, drag race or acceleration contest, test of physical
- 11 endurance, exhibition of speed or acceleration, or for the purpose
- 12 of making a speed record, and no person shall in any manner
- 13 participate in any such race, speed competition, drag race,
- 14 test * * * of physical endurance, exhibition, or purpose of making
- 15 a speed record.
- 16 (2) For the purposes of this section, "drag race" means the
- 17 operation of two (2) or more vehicles from a point side by side at
- 18 accelerating speeds in a competitive attempt to outdistance each
- 19 other, or the operation of one or more vehicles over a common

- 20 selected course, from the same point to the same point, for the
- 21 purpose of comparing the relative speeds or power of acceleration
- 22 of such vehicle or vehicles within a certain distance or time
- 23 limit on the public roads of this state.
- 24 (3) For the purposes of this section, "racing" means the use
- 25 of one or more vehicles in an attempt to outgain, outdistance, or
- 26 prevent another vehicle from passing, or to test the physical
- 27 stamina or endurance of drivers over long-distance driving routes
- 28 on the public roads of this state.
- 29 (4) Any person convicted of violating this section shall be
- 30 guilty of a * * * felony and, upon conviction, shall be fined not
- 31 more than * * * Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) or * * *
- 32 commitment to the custody of the State Department of Corrections
- 33 not to exceed two (2) years, or both.
- 34 (5) The prohibitions contained in this section do not apply
- 35 to events sanctioned by local governing authorities.
- 36 **SECTION 2.** (1) It shall be unlawful for any person or
- 37 persons to willfully obstruct by the use or operation of a motor
- 38 vehicle the free, convenient and normal use of any public
- 39 sidewalk, street, highway, alley, road, or other passageway by
- 40 impeding, hindering, stifling, retarding or restraining traffic or
- 41 passage thereon, and any person or persons violating the
- 42 provisions of this section shall be quilty of a felony, and upon
- 43 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than
- 44 Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) or commitment to the custody of

- 45 the State Department of Corrections not to exceed two (2) years,
- 46 or both.
- 47 (2) The provisions of this section are supplementary to the
- 48 provisions of any other statute of this state.
- 49 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 50 and after July 1, 2021.
