- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-37-30, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS NEAR PROPERTY WHERE
- 3 PETROLEUM PRODUCTS ARE LOCATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-37-30, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 97-37-30. (1) A person who willfully discharges his or her
- 8 firearm toward the dwelling of another, causing property damage to
- 9 the dwelling or any domesticated animal or livestock, is guilty of
- 10 a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than One Thousand
- 11 Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisonment not exceeding twelve (12)
- 12 months in the county jail, or both.
- 13 (2) A person who willfully discharges his or her firearm
- 14 near any business or property that contains flammable or explosive
- 15 petroleum products is quilty of a felony punishable by a fine of
- 16 not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or imprisonment
- 17 not exceeding five (5) years in the custody of the Department of
- 18 Corrections, or both.

19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

20 and after July 1, 2021.
