HOUSE BILL NO. 782

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO TRACK 2 FOOD DESERTS WITHIN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, AND TO PROVIDE AN 3 ANNUAL REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE BY DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR IDENTIFYING THE LOCATION OF FOOD DESERTS IN THE STATE AND HEALTH 5 ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH FOOD DESERTS; TO DEFINE THE TERM "FOOD DESERT"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 8 SECTION 1. The State Department of Health shall provide an annual report to the Legislature by December 31 of each year, 9 which identifies the locations of food deserts within the State of 10

- Mississippi and provides information about health issues associated with food deserts. If the annual report contains 12
- 13 information from the federal government that identifies the
- 14 locations of food deserts in the state, and provides information
- 15 on health issues associated with food deserts, then the
- requirements of this section shall be satisfied. For the 16
- purposes of this section, the term "food desert" means an area 17
- 18 with a poverty rate of at least twenty percent (20%) and where at
- 19 least one-third (1/3) of the population lives more than a mile
- 20 from a supermarket or large grocery store, farmers' market or

- 21 healthy food provider, and is therefore void of fresh fruit,
- 22 vegetables and other healthful whole foods, due, in part, to a
- 23 lack of access and availability of such establishments.
- 24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 25 and after July 1, 2021.
