AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 5-1-41, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE TO WAIVE ALL OR ANY PORTION OF THE COMPENSATION FOR A REGULAR SESSION OR AN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION, AND AUTHORIZE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND THE 5 LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR TO WAIVE ALL OR ANY PORTION OF THE OUT-OF-SESSION MONTHLY OFFICE EXPENSE ALLOWANCE; TO AUTHORIZE 7 MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR TO REVOKE OR REVISE THE AMOUNT OF THEIR WAIVER OF COMPENSATION OR THE 8 9 MONTHLY OFFICE EXPENSE ALLOWANCE AT ANY TIME; AND FOR RELATED 10 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 **SECTION 1.** Section 5-1-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 13 amended as follows: 5-1-41. (1) \* \* \* Except as otherwise provided in 14 15 subsection (2) of this section, each Senator and Representative of 16 the Legislature shall receive as compensation at each regular 17 session the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) and the mileage allowance provided by Section 25-3-41, for each mile of 18 the distance by the most direct route usually traveled in coming 19 20 to and returning from the place where the Legislature sits. \* \* \* Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) of this section, 21 22 each Senator and Representative shall receive for attending each
