## HOUSE BILL NO. 1146

- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 3-3-63, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DESIGNATE APRIL 13-19 OF EACH YEAR AS "MISSISSIPPI
- 3 MOSQUITO AND WEST NILE VIRUS AWARENESS WEEK"; AND FOR RELATED
- 4 PURPOSES.
- 5 WHEREAS, warming temperatures combined with late spring rains
- 6 create ideal conditions for mosquitoes to breed, including the
- 7 mosquitoes that transmit West Nile Virus; and
- 8 WHEREAS, mosquitoes infected with West Nile Virus, which is
- 9 caught by them from infected birds, can transfer it to humans and
- 10 other animals, and humans infected with the virus, particularly
- 11 children, people with weakened immune systems, and the elderly,
- 12 may become seriously ill; and
- 13 WHEREAS, in 2018, Mississippi had 50 human cases of West Nile
- 14 Virus, with no deaths, and in 2017, the state had 63 cases with
- 15 two deaths; and
- 16 WHEREAS, most cases reportedly occur between July and
- 17 September, and infected persons may experience symptoms including
- 18 fever, headache, nausea, vomiting, rash, muscle weakness or
- 19 swollen lymph nodes; and

- 20 WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that all public schools
- 21 teach prevention of West Nile Virus in the health, science and
- 22 biology classes and include insect repellent as part of the school
- 23 supplies that are in each classroom at the start of the school
- 24 year, particularly for the elementary grades; and
- 25 WHEREAS, managing mosquitoes has been a function of the State
- 26 Department of Health, and West Nile Virus awareness is a related
- 27 public health issue: NOW, THEREFORE,
- 28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 29 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 30 3-3-63, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 31 3-3-63. The week of April 13-19 of each year is designated
- 32 as "Mississippi Mosquito and West Nile Virus Awareness Week" to
- 33 promote awareness of the importance of effectively managing
- 34 mosquitoes and the prevention of West Nile Virus.
- 35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 36 and after July 1, 2021.
