1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM GENERAL FUND IN THE STATE 2 TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE FIRE ACADEMY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 6 7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Fire Academy for the fiscal year beginning 8 9 July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022.....\$ 5,098,824.00. 10 11 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 12 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in 13 the State Treasury to the credit of the State Fire Academy which 14 is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of defraying the 15 16 expenses of the department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022.....\$ 538,350.00. 17

25 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 26 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2023 do not 27 28 exceed Fiscal Year 2022 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2022 29 30 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 31 32 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 34 act. Absent a special situation or circumstance approved by the State Personnel Board, or unless otherwise authorized by this act, 35 36 no state agency shall take any action to promote or otherwise 37 award salary increases through reallocation or realignment. Ιf 38 the State Personnel Board determines a special situation or 39 circumstance exists and approves an action, then the agency and 40 the State Personnel Board shall provide a monthly report of each action approved by the State Personnel Board to the chairmen of 41 the Accountability, Efficiency and Transparency Committees of the 42

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43 Senate and House of Representatives and the chairmen of the 44 Appropriations Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives. It shall be the responsibility of the agency 45 46 head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this 47 projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2022 appropriations 48 for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the 49 50 agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State 51 Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action 52 which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2022 "Personal Services" appropriated level, 53 54 when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the 55 projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be 56 processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the 57 requirements of this provision are met.

58 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 60 61 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 62 The 63 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 64 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 65 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 66 appropriated level.

H. B. No. 1380 21/HR43/A502SG PAGE 3 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

75 Funds have been appropriated herein for the purpose of 76 implementation and funding Project SEC2 of the Colonel Guy Groff 77 State Variable Compensation Plan beginning January 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2022. It shall be the agency's responsibility to 78 79 make certain that each person, excluding executive directors, agency heads, and elected judges, shall receive no more than a 3% 80 81 annual increase in salary which shall not exceed the market rate 82 established by the State Personnel Board pursuant to the Colonel 83 Guy Groff State Variable Compensation Plan for each

84 classification.

85 SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 86 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 87 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 88 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 89 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 90 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 91 performance measures provided below:

97 A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets 98 set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the 99 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget 100 Committee for Fiscal Year 2023.

101 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 102 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and 103 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 104 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 105 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 106 2021. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 107 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2023 shall be submitted to 108 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 109 110 during the Fiscal Year 2022 budget request process.

111 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that 112 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 113 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 114 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 115 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 116 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

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117 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 118 made without competitive bids.

119 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 120 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 121 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 122 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 123 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 124 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 125 actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

132 SECTION 9. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 133 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated for the State Fire Academy 134 135 for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of Capital 136 Expense Funds, as authorized in HB 1699, 2020 Regular Session to 137 provide for Airport Rescue Crash Truck for the fiscal year 138 beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022....\$ 84,500.00. 139 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 140 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2021. 141
