HOUSE BILL NO. 1507

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 947, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2011,
2 AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 950, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2012, AS
3 AMENDED BY CHAPTER 920, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2013, TO EXPAND
4 THE BOUNDARIES OF THE MARSHALL UTILITY SERVICES SEWER DISTRICT;
5 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 947, Local and Private Laws of 2011, as
8 amended by Chapter 950, Local and Private Laws of 2012, as amended
9 by Chapter 920, Local and Private Laws of 2013, is amended as
10 follows:

11 Section 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Marshall County,
12 Mississippi, is authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to
13 establish the Marshall Utility Services Sewer District which shall
14 be composed of * * * land in Marshall County, Mississippi, being
15 more particularly described as follows:

16 (a) All land lying situated in Northwest Marshall
17 County, Mississippi, in Township 1 South, Range 4
18 West, Township 2 South, Range 4 West and Township 3
19 South, Range 4 West that has been franchised,



20 designated and granted to Marshall Utility Services by
21 way of certificates of public convenience and
22 necessity issued by the Public Service Commission.

23 (b) Begin at a point on the west line of Section 13,
24 Township 1 South, Range 5 West, Marshall County,
25 Mississippi, located 1,200.0 feet, more or less, north
26 of the southwest corner of said section, said point
27 also being located on the Mississippi-Tennessee State
28 line and on the centerline of MS Hwy 309; run thence
29 east along said Mississippi-Tennessee State line a
30 distance of 9.0 section miles to a point on the east
31 line of Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 3 West;
32 run thence south, leaving said Mississippi-Tennessee
33 State line, along said east line a distance of 1,200.0
34 feet, more or less, to the northeast corner of Section
35 20, Township 1 South, Range 3 West; run thence south
36 along section lines a distance of 2.0 section miles to
37 the southeast corner of Section 29, Township 1 South,
38 Range 3 West; run thence west along section lines a
39 distance of 1.0 section mile to the southeast corner
40 of Section 30, Township 1 South, Range 3 West; run
41 thence south along section lines a distance of 3.0
42 section miles to the southeast corner of Section 7,
43 Township 2 South, Range 3 West; run thence west along
44 section lines a distance of 2.0 section miles to the



45 southwest corner of Section 12, Township 2 South,
46 Range 4 West; run thence north along the west section
47 line of said section a distance of 1.0 section mile to
48 the southeast corner of Section 2, Township 2 South,
49 Range 4 West; run thence west along section lines a
50 distance of 6.0 section miles to the southwest corner
51 of Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 5 West located
52 in the centerline of MS Hwy 309; run thence north
53 along section lines and said centerline a distance of
54 4.0 section miles to the southwest corner of Section
55 13, Township 1 South, Range 5 West; run thence north a
56 distance of 1,200.0 feet, more or less, along
57 the west section line of said section to a point, said
58 point being on the Mississippi-Tennessee State line
59 and also being the Point of Beginning of this
60 description if such land has been franchised,
61 designated and granted to Marshall Utility Services by
62 way of certificates of public convenience and
63 necessity issued by the Public Service Commission.

64 (2) The Board of Supervisors of Marshall County,
65 Mississippi, shall be the governing authority for the district.

66 (3) Any portion of the area described in subsection (1) of
67 this section that is presently franchised by Marshall Utility
68 Services, Inc., may be utilized by Marshall Utility Services Sewer
69 District with the permission of Marshall Utility Services, Inc.



70 Section 2. It is declared that the object and purpose of
71 creating the district is to provide sewer service to the residents
72 of the area described in Section 1 of this act and to provide ways
73 and means to carry out and accomplish that purpose, thereby
74 benefiting and making more valuable the lands in the district and
75 preserving and promoting the health, safety and convenience of the
76 residents in the district. In order to carry out and render
77 effective the object and the purpose of this act, the courts of
78 this state shall construe this act as an exercise by the
79 Legislature of all the power appertaining to it that is necessary
80 for the benefit of the health, safety and convenience of the
81 residents of the district. All the terms and provisions of this
82 act are to be liberally construed to effectuate the purposes set
83 forth in this act and all powers required to accomplish the
84 purposes of this act are granted and conferred.

85 Section 3. The district created pursuant to the provisions
86 of this act, acting by and through the Board of Supervisors of
87 Marshall County, Mississippi, its governing authority, shall have
88 all powers with respect to wastewater facilities granted to
89 districts by Section 19-5-151 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

90 Section 4. The property and revenue of the district shall
91 be exempt from all state, county and municipal taxation.

92 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
93 and after its passage.
