- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Mr. Antonio Simpson of Tunica County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction for the crime of Armed Robbery and Aggravated Assault
- 8 on March 26, 1997, in Tunica County, Mississippi, for which he was
- 9 sentenced to serve six (6) years on each count to run concurrently
- 10 in the custody of the Department of Corrections.
- 11 He completed all terms and conditions of his sentence and was
- 12 discharged on March 3, 2003. The Legislature is informed that he
- 13 has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen
- 14 in a good and lawful manner.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after its passage.
