- 27 Efficiency and Transparency; Education; Finance; Investigate State
- 28 Offices; Judiciary Division A; and Universities and Colleges; and
- 29 as a former head of Mississippi's lead economic development
- 30 agency, he understood the impact that a trained and educated
- 31 workforce within our state has on prospective employers, both from
- 32 existing and new businesses, and that education and job creation
- 33 should go hand in hand; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Senator Hale was born in Memphis, Tennessee, on
- 35 March 28, 1954, and he is married to the former Cindy Rials, and
- 36 they have two children, Jennifer Hale Lowrie and Jay Hale, and
