A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MARCH 2021 AS "KIDNEY DISEASE AWARENESS MONTH" AND MARCH 11, 2021, AS "WORLD KIDNEY DAY" IN MISSISSIPPI.

- 4 WHEREAS, chronic kidney disease (CKD) is the progressive,
- 5 gradual loss of kidney function which results in a decrease in the
- 6 ability of the kidneys to remove waste from the body; and
- 7 WHEREAS, it is estimated that 37 million adults in the United
- 8 States have CKD, and of those, approximately 90 percent remain
- 9 undiagnosed; and
- 10 WHEREAS, without diagnosis and treatment to slow its
- 11 progression, CKD can progress to end-stage renal failure, which is
- 12 fatal unless the patient receives dialysis or a kidney transplant;
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, CKD is associated with more severe COVID-19
- 15 infections, and COVID-19 may cause acute kidney damage that can
- 16 lead to dialysis or even death; and
- 17 WHEREAS, regular screening and early detection can prevent
- 18 the progression of kidney disease to kidney failure, and it is

- 21 WHEREAS, kidney disease awareness empowers patients and
- 22 families to seek diagnosis, support, and appropriate treatment:
