HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 58

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION APPLYING FOR A UNITED STATES
CONSTITUTION ARTICLE V AMENDMENTS CONVENTION SPECIFICALLY RELATING
TO A FEDERAL BALANCED BUDGET REQUIREMENT.

- 4 WHEREAS, Article V of the Constitution of the United States
- 5 provides authority for a convention to be called by the Congress
- 6 of the United States for the purpose of proposing amendments to
- 7 the Constitution upon application of two-thirds (2/3) of the
- 8 Legislatures of the several states ("Madison Amendments
- 9 Convention"); and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Mississippi favors
- 11 the proposal and ratification of an amendment to the Constitution
- 12 which shall provide that an increase in the federal debt requires
- 13 approval from a majority of the Legislatures of the separate
- 14 states; NOW, THEREFORE,
- 15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE
- 16 OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 17 **SECTION 1.** That, the Legislature of the State of Mississippi
- 18 hereby applies to Congress, under the provisions of Article V of

- 19 the Constitution of the United States, for the calling of a
- 20 convention of the states limited to proposing an amendment to the
- 21 Constitution of the United States requiring that in the absence of
- 22 a national emergency the total of all Federal appropriations made
- 23 by the Congress for any fiscal year may not exceed the total of
- 24 all estimated Federal revenues for that fiscal year, together with
- 25 any related and appropriate fiscal restraints.
- 26 **SECTION 2.** The Secretary of State is hereby directed to
- 27 transmit copies of this application to the President and Secretary
- 28 of the Senate and to the Speaker and Clerk of the House of
- 29 Representatives of the Congress, and copies to the members of the
- 30 Senate and House of Representatives from this state; also to
- 31 transmit copies hereof to the presiding officers of each of the
- 32 legislative houses in the several states, requesting their
- 33 cooperation.
- 34 **SECTION 3.** This application is to be considered as covering
- 35 the same subject matter as the presently-outstanding balanced
- 36 budget and unlimited-subject applications from other states,
- 37 including but not limited to previously-adopted and unrescinded
- 38 applications from Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado,
- 39 Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky,
- 40 Louisiana, Michigan, Missouri, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New
- 41 Jersey, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma,
- 42 Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Washington,
- 43 Utah, West Virginia, Wyoming and Wisconsin, and this application

44 shall be aggregated with same for the purpose of attaining the 45 two-thirds (2/3) of states necessary to require the calling of a convention, but shall not be aggregated with any applications on 46 47 any other subject. SECTION 4. This application constitutes a continuing 48 49 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of 50 the United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds 51 (2/3) of the several states have made applications on the same 52 subject, and it supersedes all previous applications by this 53 Legislature on the same subject. 54 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a certified copy of this application be transmitted by the Secretary of State, to the 55 56 President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the 57 United States House of Representatives, to each member of the 58 applicant's delegation to the United States Congress, and to the 59 presiding officers of each house of the several state

Legislatures, requesting their cooperation in applying for the

Amendments Convention limited to the subject matter contemplated

by this application.
