SENATE BILL NO. 2294 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 63-1-35, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
AUTHORIZE A VETERAN TO ESTABLISH PROOF OF MILITARY SERVICE FOR
VETERAN DRIVER'S LICENSE DESIGNATION IN PERSON AT THE DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC SAFETY DRIVER'S LICENSE STATION; TO AMEND SECTION
5 97-19-85, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE CRIMINAL PENALTIES
FOR SUBMITTING FALSE DOCUMENTS TO OBTAIN A VETERAN DRIVER'S
LICENSE OR OTHER VETERAN'S BENEFITS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 63-1-35, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 63-1-35. (1) The Commissioner of Public Safety shall
- 12 prescribe the form of license issued pursuant to this article
- 13 which shall, among other features, include a driver's license
- 14 number assigned by the Department of Public Safety. A licensee
- 15 shall list his social security number with the department which
- 16 shall cross reference the social security number with the driver's
- 17 license number for purposes of identification. Additionally, each
- 18 license shall bear a full-face color photograph of the licensee in
- 19 such form that the license and the photograph cannot be separated.
- 20 The photograph shall be taken so that one (1) exposure will

- 21 photograph the applicant and the application simultaneously on the
- 22 The department shall use a process in the issuance of
- 23 a license with a color photograph that shall prevent as nearly as
- possible any alteration, counterfeiting, duplication, 24
- 25 reproduction, forging or modification of the license or the
- 26 superimposition of a photograph without ready detection.
- 27 photograph shall be replaced by the department at the time of
- renewal. Drivers' licenses, including photographs appearing 28
- 29 thereon, may be renewed by electronic means according to rules and
- regulations promulgated by the commissioner in conformity to 30
- Section 27-104-33. 31
- 32 The commissioner shall prescribe the form of license
- 33 issued pursuant to this article to licensees who are not United
- States citizens and who do not possess a social security number 34
- 35 issued by the United States government. The license of such
- 36 persons shall include a number and/or other identifying features.
- 37 Any new, renewal or duplicate driver's license,
- temporary driving permit, intermediate license or commercial 38
- 39 driver's license issued to a person required to register as a sex
- offender pursuant to Section 45-33-25 shall bear a designation 40
- 41 identifying the licensee or permittee as a sex offender.
- 42 The commissioner is authorized to provide the new,
- 43 renewal or duplicate driver's license, temporary driving permit,
- intermediate license or commercial driver's license to any 44
- honorably discharged veteran as defined in Title 38 of the United 45

- 46 States Code, and such license or permit shall exhibit the letters
- 47 "Vet" or any other mark identifying the person as a veteran. The
- 48 veteran requesting the "Vet" designation shall present his
- 49 DD-214 * * *, Military Retiree Identification Card, United States
- 50 Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Identification Card, United
- 51 States Department of Veterans Affairs Identification Card or
- 52 National Guard Form NGB 22. The veteran requesting the "Vet"
- 53 designation may present his DD-214, Military Retiree
- 54 Identification Card, United States Department of Veterans Affairs
- 55 Medical Identification Card, United States Department of Veterans
- 56 Affairs Identification Card or National Guard Form NGB 22 in
- 57 person at the Mississippi Department of Public Safety Driver's
- 58 License Station.
- 59 (5) Not later than July 1, 2021, the commissioner shall
- 60 develop and implement a driver's license or driving permit in
- 61 electronic format as an additional option for license or permit
- 62 holders. Acceptable electronic formats include display of
- 63 electronic images on a cellular phone or any other type of
- 64 electronic device.
- 65 (6) If false documents are provided by an individual for
- 66 purposes of obtaining a veteran driver's license, such action
- 67 shall be considered fraudulent use of identity under Section
- 68 97-19-85, Mississippi Code of 1972, and shall be punishable, upon
- 69 conviction, as a felony pursuant to the provisions of that
- 70 section.

- 71 **SECTION 2.** Section 97-19-85, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 72 amended as follows:
- 73 97-19-85. (1) Any person who shall make or cause to be made
- 74 any false statement or representation as to his or another
- 75 person's or entity's identity, social security account number,
- 76 credit card number, debit card number, DD-214 or other identifying
- 77 information for the purpose of fraudulently obtaining or with the
- 78 intent to obtain goods, services or any thing of value, shall be
- 79 quilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, for a first
- 80 offense shall be fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars
- 81 (\$5,000.00) or imprisoned for a term not to exceed five (5) years,
- 82 or both. For a second or subsequent offense such person, upon
- 83 conviction, shall be fined not more than Ten Thousand Dollars
- $84 \quad (\$10,000.00)$ or imprisoned for a term not to exceed ten (10)
- 85 years, or both. In addition to the fines and imprisonment
- 86 provided in this section, a person convicted under this section
- 87 shall be ordered to pay restitution as provided in Section 99-37-1
- 88 et seq.
- 89 (2) A person is guilty of fraud under subsection (1) who:
- 90 (a) Shall furnish false information willfully,
- 91 knowingly and with intent to deceive anyone as to his true
- 92 identity or the true identity of another person; or
- 93 (b) Willfully, knowingly, and with intent to deceive,
- 94 uses a social security account number to establish and maintain
- 95 business or other records; or

96	(c) With intent to deceive, falsely represents a number
97	to be the social security account number assigned to him or
98	another person, when in fact the number is not the social security
99	account number assigned to him or such other person; or
100	(d) With intent to deceive, falsely represents to be a
101	representative of an entity in order to open banking accounts,
102	obtain credit cards, or other services and supplies in the
103	entity's name; or
104	(e) Knowingly alters a social security card, buys or
105	sells a social security card or counterfeit or altered social
106	security card, counterfeits a social security card, or possesses a
107	social security card or counterfeit social security card with
108	intent to sell or alter it * * *; or
109	(f) Willfully and knowingly, with intent to deceive,
110	falsely uses a form DD-214, Military Retiree Identification Card,
111	United States Department of Veterans Affairs Medical
112	Identification Card, United States Department of Veterans Affairs
113	Identification Card or National Guard Form NGB 22, for the purpose
114	of fraudulently obtaining a veterans driver's license or any other
115	state or federal government benefit available only to honorably
116	discharged veterans.
