## SENATE BILL NO. 2529

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-16-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT END-OF-COURSE ASSESSMENTS REQUIRED FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION SHALL INCLUDE ONLY THOSE REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-16-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-16-7. (1) Each district school board shall establish
- 9 standards for graduation from its schools which shall include as a
- 10 minimum:
- 11 (a) Mastery of minimum academic skills as measured by
- 12 assessments developed and administered by the State Board of
- 13 Education, provided that end-of-course assessments required for
- 14 graduation shall only include those that are required by federal
- 15 law.
- 16 (b) Completion of a minimum number of academic credits,
- 17 and all other applicable requirements prescribed by the district
- 18 school board.

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- 20 rates. High schools with graduation rates lower than eighty
- 21 percent (80%) must submit a detailed plan to the Mississippi
- 22 Department of Education to restructure the high school experience
- 23 to improve graduation rates.
- 24 (2) A student who meets all requirements prescribed in
- 25 subsection (1) of this section shall be awarded a standard diploma
- 26 in a form prescribed by the State Board of Education.
- 27 (3) The State Board of Education may establish student
- 28 proficiency standards for promotion to grade levels leading to
- 29 graduation.
- 30 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 31 and after July 1, 2021.
