1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI AGRICULTURAL AND FORESTRY EXPERIMENT STATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
8	maintenance of the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry
9	Experiment Station for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and
10	ending June 30, 2022 \$ 21,740,924.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
13	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
14	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi
15	Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station for the fiscal year
16	beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022
17	\$ 10,355,234.00.

- 18 **SECTION 3.** No general funds authorized to be expended herein
- 19 shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds
- 20 which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions
- 21 of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 22 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that if
- 23 the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly
- 24 or indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants,
- 25 research grants or donations, such special source funds not
- 26 classified as current restricted funds shall be added and
- 27 accounted for under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the
- 28 intention of the Legislature that all such aforementioned special
- 29 source funds be included in all reports and requests for the 2022
- 30 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature.
- 31 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 32 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2023 shall be submitted to
- 33 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 34 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 35 during the Fiscal Year 2022 budget request process.
- 36 **SECTION 6.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One
- 37 Million Two Hundred Thirty-five Thousand Five Hundred
- 38 Seventy-eight Dollars (\$1,235,578.00) shall be derived from the
- 39 Education Enhancement Fund from funds deposited pursuant to
- 40 Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 41 **SECTION 7.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 42 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of

43	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
44	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
45	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
46	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
47	performance measures provided below:

- 67 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
- 68 Committee for Fiscal Year 2023.
- 69 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 70 Section 2, Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00), or so much
- 71 thereof, shall be derived out of any money in the State Treasury
- 72 to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, as created in Section
- 73 27-103-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, and allocated in a manner as
- 74 determined by the Treasurer's Office. These funds are provided
- 75 for operational expenditures.
- 76 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 77 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 78 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 79 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 80
- 81 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 82 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 83 made without competitive bids.
- 84 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 85 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 86
- 87 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 88
- 89 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- actions contrary to this provision. 90

SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2021.
