SENATE BILL NO. 3082

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 947, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2011,
2 AS LAST AMENDED BY CHAPTER 920, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2013, TO
3 REVISE THE GEOGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION OF THE MARSHALL UTILITY SERVICES
4 SEWER DISTRICT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 947, Local and Private Laws of 2011, as
7 amended by Chapter 950, Local and Private Laws of 2012, as amended
8 by Chapter 920, Local and Private Laws of 2013, is amended as
9 follows:

10 Section 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Marshall County,
11 Mississippi, is authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to
12 establish the Marshall Utility Services Sewer District which shall
13 be composed of a tract of land in Marshall County, Mississippi,
14 being more particularly described as follows:

15 * * *

16 Begin at a point on the west line of Section 13,
17 Township 1 South, Range 5 West, Marshall County,
18 Mississippi, located 1,200.0 feet, more or less, north
19 of the southwest corner of said section, said point also



20 being located on the Mississippi-Tennessee state line
21 and on the centerline of MS Hwy 309; run thence east
22 along said Mississippi-Tennessee state line a distance
23 of 9.0 section miles to a point on the east line of
24 Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 3 West; run thence
25 south, leaving said Mississippi-Tennessee state line,
26 along said east line a distance of 1,200.0 feet, more or
27 less, to the northeast corner of Section 20, Township 1
28 South, Range 3 West; run thence south along section
29 lines a distance of 2.0 section miles to the southeast
30 corner of Section 29, Township 1 South, Range 3 West;
31 run thence west along section lines a distance of 1.0
32 section mile to the southeast corner of Section 30,
33 Township 1 South, Range 3 West; run thence south along
34 section lines a distance of 3.0 section miles to the
35 southeast corner of Section 7, Township 2 South, Range 3
36 West; run thence west along section lines a distance of
37 2.0 section miles to the southwest corner of Section 12,
38 Township 2 South, Range 4 West; run thence north along
39 the west section line of said section a distance of 1.0
40 section mile to the southeast corner of Section 2,
41 Township 2 South, Range 4 West; run thence west along
42 section lines a distance of 6.0 section miles to the
43 southwest corner of Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 5
44 West located in the centerline of MS Hwy 309; run thence



45 north along section lines and said centerline a distance
46 of 4.0 section miles to the southwest corner of Section
47 13, Township 1 South, Range 5 West; run thence north a
48 distance of 1,200.0 feet, more or less, along the west
49 section line of said section to a point, said point
50 being on the Mississippi-Tennessee State line and also
51 being the Point of Beginning of this description.

52 (2) The Board of Supervisors of Marshall County,
53 Mississippi, shall be the governing authority for the district.

54 (3) Any portion of the area described in subsection (1) of
55 this section that is presently franchised by Marshall Utility
56 Services, Inc., may be utilized by Marshall Utility Services Sewer
57 District with the permission of Marshall Utility Services, Inc.

58 Section 2. It is declared that the object and purpose of
59 creating the district is to provide sewer service to the residents
60 of the area described in Section 1 of this act and to provide ways
61 and means to carry out and accomplish that purpose, thereby
62 benefiting and making more valuable the lands in the district and
63 preserving and promoting the health, safety and convenience of the
64 residents in the district. In order to carry out and render
65 effective the object and the purpose of this act, the courts of
66 this state shall construe this act as an exercise by the
67 Legislature of all the power appertaining to it that is necessary
68 for the benefit of the health, safety and convenience of the
69 residents of the district. All the terms and provisions of this



70 act are to be liberally construed to effectuate the purposes set
71 forth in this act and all powers required to accomplish the
72 purposes of this act are granted and conferred.

73 Section 3. The district created pursuant to the provisions
74 of this act, acting by and through the Board of Supervisors of
75 Marshall County, Mississippi, its governing authority, shall have
76 all powers with respect to wastewater facilities granted to
77 districts by Section 19-5-151 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

78 Section 4. The property and revenue of the district shall
79 be exempt from all state, county and municipal taxation.

80 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
81 and after its passage.
