SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 536

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING OF THE STATE TAXATION STUDY COMMITTEE TO EXAMINE AND DEVELOP RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING STATE TAX POLICY.
- WHEREAS, the Legislature finds advisable the establishment of
- 5 the State Taxation Study Committee to examine and develop
- 6 recommendations regarding state tax policy; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the committee shall, at a minimum, study and report
- 8 to the 2022 Regular Session of the Legislature the committee's
- 9 recommendations regarding the most effective and desirable policy
- 10 changes with respect to state income tax, state sales tax and
- 11 state use tax; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the committee shall provide the provisions of the
- 13 current Mississippi law that will need to be amended to adopt the
- 14 measures described in this section and any other measures
- 15 recommended by the committee; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the committee shall be composed of the following
- 17 members:

18	(a) The Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of
19	Revenue, or his/her designee;
20	(b) Four (4) members of the Mississippi State Senate
21	appointed by the Lieutenant Governor;
22	(c) Four (4) members of the Mississippi House of
23	Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House;
24	(d) The Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee;
25	(e) The Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee;
26	(f) The Chairman of the Senate Appropriations
27	Committee;
28	(g) The Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee;

30	(h) The State Economist; and
31	WHEREAS, appointments to the study committee shall be made
32	within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this act; and
33	WHEREAS, at the first meeting, the committee shall elect from
34	among its membership a chairman, a vice chairman and any other
35	officers determined to be necessary, and shall adopt rules for
36	transacting business and keeping records; and
37	WHEREAS, a majority of the members of the study committee
38	shall constitute a quorum; and
39	WHEREAS, in the adoption of rules, resolutions and reports,
40	and in the election of a chairman, vice chairman and any other
41	officers determined to be necessary, an affirmative vote of a

majority of the members present shall be required; and

44	and other support necessary for the study committee to perform its
