- 10 Biggersville to win the MHSAA 1A State Championship Game 20-14.
- 11 The win on December 4, 2020, in Mississippi Veterans Memorial
- 12 Stadium makes up for Lumberton's loss in the state championship
- 13 last season. The Panthers finished the season 12-1; and

- 14 WHEREAS, the Panthers also received vital efforts from
- 15 Running Back Robert Henry who rushed 27 times for 111 yards and
- 16 one touchdown and Wide Receiver K'nylan Willis who caught five
- 17 passes for 59 yards and one touchdown. Lumberton led for most of
- 18 the game, but Biggersville took advantage of a late opportunity.

- 19 Lumberton punted with 2:15 remaining and Biggersville returned the
- 20 punt to its own 45-yard line, giving the Lions one last chance to
- 21 come back. Lumberton took over following that drive and needed
- 22 five plays to retake the lead and seize the school's first state
- 23 championship since 2010; and
- 24 WHEREAS, "I think it's the biggest life lesson you can have,"
- 25 Lumberton Coach Zach Jones said. "You can get your head down but
- 26 you can't lay down. When bad things happen, you've got to fight.
- 27 We did today and fortunately we were able to get it"; and
