4	WHEREAS, the Governor's Arts Awards Program has announced its
5	2021 recipients, which includes Nellie McInnis for Excellence in
6	Music; and
7	WHEREAS, established in 1988, Governor's Arts Awards are
8	given to individuals and organizations to recognize outstanding
9	work in the artistic disciplines, as well as arts-based community
10	development and arts patronage in Mississippi. The awards are
11	presented in partnership with the Governor's Office and signify
12	the important relationship between government and the arts; and
13	WHEREAS, known to her fans as "Nellie Mack," Nellie McInnis
14	grew up in the capital city with a strong love for music. Though
15	she was steered toward the piano, Nellie Mack rejected gender
16	stereotypes and pursued the bass guitar; and
17	WHEREAS, while studying music at Jackson State University,

- 21 WHEREAS, McInnis' skill on the electric bass was quickly
- 22 noticed, and she took her high-energy performing style to
- 23 audiences across the state, the nation and as far as Finland,
- 24 Belgium, and Norway. She has shared the stage with some of the
- 25 greatest musicians of the modern era, including Jazz Legend Ellis
- 26 Marsalis, R&B Hitmakers The Bar-Kays, Bluesman Bobby Bland,
- 27 Governor's Arts Award recipient Dorothy Moore, Clark Terry and the
- 28 late Jazz Giant Dizzy Gillespie; and
- 29 WHEREAS, in recent years, McInnis has settled back in her
- 30 hometown of Jackson to be close to family. She formed her popular
- 31 live band "The Nellie Mack Project" and plays regularly at her
- 32 church; and
- 33 WHEREAS, McInnis remains a highly sought-after live performer
- 34 but is also committed to music education. She received a Master's
- 35 of Music Education from Jackson State University and dedicates
- 36 time to teaching young people about music as a member of the
- 37 Mississippi Arts Commission's Artist Roster; and
- 38 WHEREAS, before the quarantine in 2020 brought live
- 39 performances to a near standstill, Nellie Mack played regularly at
- 40 festivals and concerts around the region. Her hope, and that of
- 41 her fans, is that Nellie Mack will be bringing her stellar
- 42 musicianship and show-stopping performances back to audiences in
- 43 the very near future; and
