SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 17

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING PASCAGOULA NATIVE SARAH THOMAS FOR MAKING HISTORY AS THE FIRST FEMALE REFEREE TO OFFICIATE A SUPER BOWL.

- WHEREAS, history was made during the February 7, 2021, Super
- 5 Bowl in Tampa, Florida, when Pascagoula native Sarah Thomas made
- 6 her debut as the NFL's first female referee to officiate a Super
- 7 Bowl. She served as a Line Judge in the Championship Game between
- 8 the Kansas City Chiefs and the Tampa Bay Buccaneers; and
- 9 WHEREAS, from Pascagoula to Raymond James Stadium in Tampa
- 10 Bay takes about eight hours by car but for NFL Official Sarah
- 11 Thomas and her family, it has been a much longer journey. "We
- 12 knew that she had determination and whatever was put before her,
- 13 she would conquer," said her mother, Donna Bailey. "Sarah has
- 14 always been the trailblazer," said Sarah's brother, Scott Bailey.
- 15 "Just get her the opportunity and she will show you what she can
- 16 do. She puts her time and effort into it and she has deserved
- 17 it." On the field and off, Sarah's family has always been her
- 18 support system in more ways than one. Her two brothers, Lea and

- 19 Scott, are also football officials. "I am so proud of my daughter
- 20 but I am also so proud of my two sons," said Sarah's father,
- 21 Spencer Bailey. "They are part of the reason she is where she is
- 22 and they encouraged her and supported her in all the ways brothers
- 23 can do." At the end of the day, Sarah and her family know she has
- 24 a job to do and they believe the skills that got her to the
- 25 biggest stage in football will carry her far beyond it; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Thomas began her officiating career in 1996, when
- 27 she attended a meeting of the Gulf Coast Football Officials
- 28 Association. She worked her first varsity high school game in
- 29 1999. In 2006, Gerry Austin, Conference USA's Coordinator of
- 30 Officials and a former NFL official, invited her to an official's
- 31 camp. Austin was impressed with her skills and hired her for the
- 32 Conference USA staff. In 2007, Sarah became the first woman to
- 33 officiate a major college football game, working a game between
- 34 Memphis and Jacksonville State. On November 12, 2011, Sarah
- 35 Thomas became the first woman to officiate in a Big Ten stadium,
- 36 working as a line judge when Northwestern hosted Rice; and
- 37 WHEREAS, during the 2009 season, Thomas was one of five
- 38 female officials in major college football and the only one at the
- 39 Football Bowl Subdivision level. She was assigned to a crew and
- 40 given a full schedule of 11 games. At the end of the season, she
- 41 was selected to work the Little Caesars Pizza Bowl between
- 42 Marshall and Ohio, making her the first woman to officiate a bowl
- 43 game. Thomas has officiated United Football League Games, and in

- 44 2010 worked the League Championship Game. In 2013, Thomas became
- 45 one of 21 finalists in contention for a permanent NFL officiating
- 46 position. Thomas worked New Orleans Saints scrimmages, and was
- 47 part of the NFL officiating development program; and
- WHEREAS, on April 8, 2015, the NFL officially announced that
- 49 Thomas would become the first full-time female official in NFL
- 50 history, and was assigned to officiating Crew Head Referee Pet
- 51 Morelli. Thomas made her NFL regular season debut in a game
- 52 between the Kansas City Chiefs and the Houston Texans at NRG
- 53 Stadium on September 13, 2015. Thomas' NFL officiating uniform
- 54 number is 153; and
- 55 WHEREAS, "Football has played a very impactful role in my
- 56 life...It has enhanced the foundation that my parents have laid
- 57 before me, all those coaches have laid before me, and my ability
- 58 to just try to keep it together, problem solve, work as a team,
- 59 and also just be a part of a crew of officials," she said. "It
- 60 has taught me so much about life... I absolutely love officiating
- 61 football. It is the longevity of your career that you really want
- 62 to establish. Being granted the honor of working a Super Bowl
- 63 means that you finish top of your position." Throughout her
- 64 journey, rather than specifically dreaming about officiating the
- 65 Super Bowl, Thomas simply hoped to be the best at her job; and
- 66 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we commend this
- 67 Mississippi citizen who is a pioneer in her field and has brought

- 68 honor to her family, her community and to the State of
- 69 Mississippi:
- 70 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 71 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby recognize Sarah Thomas of Brandon,
- 72 Mississippi, for making history as the first female referee to
- 73 officiate a Super Bowl and as a pioneer in female football
- 74 officiating, and extend the best wishes of the Legislature to
- 75 Sarah and her family as her landmark career continues.
- 76 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be presented to
- 77 Sarah Thomas, forwarded to the NFL corporate office, and be made
- 78 available to the Capitol Press Corps.
