

House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2746

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

1 **AMEND** on lines 11-14 by striking "'down syndrome" shall mean
2 a chromosomal condition caused by an error in all cell division
3 that results in the presence of an extra or partial copy of
4 chromosome 21." and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 "chromosomal disorder" means trisomy 13 (otherwise known as Patau
6 syndrome); trisomy 18 (otherwise known as Edwards syndrome); or
7 trisomy 21 (otherwise known as Down syndrome)."

8 **AMEND FURTHER** on lines 18, 24, 26, 32-33, 36 and 40 by
9 striking the words "down syndrome" and insert in lieu thereof "a
10 chromosomal disorder".

11 **AMEND FURTHER** on line 27 by striking the words "down syndrome
12 organization and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
13 "advocacy organizations for people with intellectual and other
14 developmental disorders".

15 **AMEND FURTHER** on line 34 by striking the words "down
16 syndrome".

17 **AMEND FURTHER** the title on lines 3 and 5 by deleting the
18 words "DOWN SYNDROME" and inserting in lieu thereof the words
19 "CHROMOSOMAL DISORDER".
