## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2921

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be				
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State				
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of				
8	defraying the expenses of the Commission on Judicial Performance				
9	of the State of Mississippi for the fiscal year beginning July 1,				
10	2021, and ending June 30, 2022\$ 525,399.00.				
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be				
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State				
13	Treasury to the credit of the Commission on Judicial Performance,				
14	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Commission on				
15	Judicial Performance of the State of Mississippi for the fiscal				
16	year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022				
17	\$ 40,029.00.				
18	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of				
19	this act, the following positions are authorized:

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 31 32 Judicial Performance Commission shall maintain complete accounting 33 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 34 35 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 36 2021. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 37 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2023 shall be submitted to 38 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 39 40 during the Fiscal Year 2022 budget request process.

41 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 42 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 43 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 44 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 45 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 46 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

S. B. 2921 PAGE 2 47 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 48 made without competitive bids.

49 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 50 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 51 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 52 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 53 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 54 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 55 actions contrary to this provision.

56 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 57 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 58 59 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 60 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 61 62 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 63 and after July 1, 2021, and shall stand repealed from and after 64 June 29, 2021.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE COMMISSION ON JUDICIAL PERFORMANCE OF THE 3 STATE OF MISSISSIPPI FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022.
