- AMEND after line 70 by inserting the following:

 SECTION 3. Section 23-15-300, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
 amended as follows:
- 4 23-15-300. (1) Any candidate for any municipal, county or
- 5 county district office shall be a resident of the municipality,
- 6 county, county district or other territory that he or she seeks to
- 7 represent in such office for two (2) years immediately preceding
- 8 the day of election. Notwithstanding the foregoing two-year
- 9 residency requirement for holding a municipal office, a candidate
- 10 seeking to represent a ward need only be a resident of the
- 11 municipality for two (2) years prior to the day of the election,
- 12 but he or she need only be a resident of the ward he or she seeks
- 13 to represent at the time of qualification of office. The
- 14 provisions of this section shall not apply to any municipality



- 15 with less than one thousand (1,000) residents according to the
- 16 latest federal decennial census.
- 17 (2) A candidate shall prove in his or her qualifying
- 18 information that he or she meets the applicable residency
- 19 requirement or provide absolute proof, subject to no
- 20 contingencies, that he or she will meet the residency requirement
- 21 on or before the date of the election at which the candidate could
- 22 be elected to office. The appropriate election official or
- 23 executive committee, whichever is applicable, with whom a
- 24 candidate files qualifying information shall review and determine
- 25 whether the candidate meets the applicable residency requirement
- 26 according to the procedures in Section 23-15-299. The appropriate
- 27 election commission shall review and determine whether a candidate
- 28 required to file qualifying information with it meets the
- 29 applicable residency requirement according to the procedures in
- 30 Section 23-15-359.
- 31 (3) If the qualifications for an elected office include a
- 32 specific residency requirement, the residency requirement in this
- 33 section shall not apply.
- 34 (4) This section shall apply to elections held from and
- 35 after January 1, 2020."
- 36 **AMEND further** by renumbering the succeeding section
- 37 accordingly.
