Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 SECTION 1. Section 73-54-23, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 73-54-23. (1) The board shall issue a license by 10 examination of credentials to any applicant licensed or certified 11 as a marriage and family therapist in another state that has such 12 requirements for the license or certificate that the board is of the opinion that the applicant is competent to engage in the 13 14 practice of marriage and family therapy in this state, provided 15 that the applicant submits an application on forms prescribed by 16 the board, has passed the national Examination in Marital and

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Family Therapy, and pays the * * * licensure fee prescribed by Section * * * <u>73-54-27</u>. The issuance of a license by reciprocity to a military-trained applicant or military spouse shall be subject to the provisions of Section 73-50-1.

21 The board shall issue a temporary license by examination (2) 22 of credentials to any applicant who has been licensed or certified for at least one (1) year as a social worker or marriage and 23 24 family therapist in another state that has such requirements for 25 the license or certificate for the same scope of practice that the 26 board is of the opinion that the applicant is competent to engage 27 in the same practice in this state, provided that the applicant 28 submits an application on forms prescribed by the board, has 29 passed the applicable national examination for marriage and family 30 therapy or the Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB) 31 examination for social workers and pays the licensure fee 32 prescribed by Section 73-54-27. The practice setting for the 33 temporary licensee shall be limited to a nonprofit health or family counseling facility. The applicant shall be required to 34 35 hold his or her license or certificate from the other state in good standing and the applicant shall be subject to a criminal 36 37 history records check by the board. The temporary license shall 38 be issued within sixty (60) days after receiving the application 39 if the applicant submits credentials affirming that he or she satisfies the provisions of this subsection (2). The applicant 40 41 may practice under the temporary license until a regular license

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42 is granted for a period not to exceed three hundred sixty-five

- 43 (365) days. Insurers shall provide reimbursement to providers
- 44 based upon the temporary license held by the applicant while the
- 45 regular license process is completed, and the insurance company
- 46 may bill for any reimbursement paid to the provider if the
- 47 application is denied.

48 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 49 and after July 1, 2021.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
