## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State

8	Landscape Architecture Advisory Committee, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses incurred by said board for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	this act, the following positions are authorized:

19 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 20 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2023 do not 21 exceed Fiscal Year 2022 funds appropriated for that purpose unless 22 23 programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2022 24 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by 25 the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 26 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 27 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 28 act. Absent a special situation or circumstance approved by the 29 State Personnel Board, or unless otherwise authorized by this act, 30 no state agency shall take any action to promote or otherwise 31 award salary increases through reallocation or realignment. Ιf the State Personnel Board determines a special situation or 32 33 circumstance exists and approves an action, then the agency and 34 the State Personnel Board shall provide a monthly report of each 35 action approved by the State Personnel Board to the chairmen of 36 the Accountability, Efficiency and Transparency Committees of the 37 Senate and House of Representatives and the chairmen of the Appropriations Committees of the Senate and House of 38 Representatives. It shall be the responsibility of the agency 39

40 head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this 41 projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2022 appropriations 42 for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of 43 escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the 44 agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State 45 Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action 46 which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2022 "Personal Services" appropriated level, 47 when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the 48 49 projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be 50 processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the 51 requirements of this provision are met.

52 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 53 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 54 55 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 56 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 57 58 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 59 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 60 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

69 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 70 Board of Architecture shall maintain complete accounting and 71 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 72 73 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 74 2021. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 75 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2023 shall be submitted to 76 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 77 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 78 during the Fiscal Year 2022 budget request process.

**SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that 79 80 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 81 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 82 83 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 84 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 85 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 86 made without competitive bids.

87 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 88 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 89 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency

90 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 91 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 92 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 93 actions contrary to this provision.

94 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 95 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 96 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 97 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 98 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 99 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2021.
