## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 136

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law
- 7 to the contrary, any public officer or employee handling or having
- 8 the custody of public funds, by virtue of his or her office or
- 9 employment, shall give an individual bond. Such bond for the
- 10 public officer or employee shall be in the amount of Twenty-five
- 11 Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), unless a specific amount is
- 12 otherwise required by law. The provisions of this section shall
- 13 not apply to any public officer or employee whose activity of
- 14 handling or having custody of public funds is incidental to his or
- 15 her employment or job duties, as defined by the regulations of the
- 16 State Auditor's office.
- 17 (2) All individual bonds as required by this section shall
- 18 follow the form and content as provided in Section 25-1-15.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2021, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2021.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO REQUIRE ANY PUBLIC OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE HANDLING OR
HAVING THE CUSTODY OF PUBLIC FUNDS, BY VIRTUE OF HIS OR HER OFFICE
OR EMPLOYMENT, TO GIVE BOND IN A CERTAIN AMOUNT; AND FOR RELATED
PURPOSES.
