Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 667

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 SECTION 1. Section 67-1-83, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 67-1-83. (1) It shall be unlawful for any permittee or *** * *** any employee or agent thereof to sell or furnish any 10 11 alcoholic beverage to any person who is visibly intoxicated, or to 12 any person who is known to habitually drink alcoholic beverages to 13 excess, or to any person who is known to be an habitual user of 14 narcotics or other habit-forming drugs. It shall also be unlawful for the holder of any package retailer's permit to sell any 15 16 alcoholic beverages except by delivery in person to the purchaser 17 at the place of business of the permittee.

18 (2) It shall be unlawful for any permittee or * * * any
19 employee or agent thereof to sell or furnish any alcoholic
20 beverage to any person to whom the * * * department has, after
21 investigation, decided to prohibit the sale of those beverages
22 because of an appeal to the * * * department so to do by the
23 husband, wife, father, mother, brother, sister, child, or employer

of the person. The interdiction in those cases shall last until removed by the * * * <u>department</u>, but no person shall be held to have violated this subsection unless he has been informed by the * * * <u>department</u>, by registered letter, that it is forbidden to sell to that individual or unless that fact is otherwise known to the permittee or * * * its employee or agent.

30 (3) It shall be unlawful for any holder of a package 31 retailer's permit, or any employee or agent thereof, engaged 32 solely in the business of package retail sales under this chapter 33 to sell or furnish any alcoholic beverage before 10:00 a.m. and 34 after 10:00 p.m. or to sell alcoholic beverages on Sunday and 35 Christmas Day.

36 Any person who violates any of the provisions of this (4) section shall be quilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, 37 38 shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars 39 (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not 40 more than six (6) months, or by both that fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court. In addition to any other 41 42 penalties prescribed by law, the commission * * * may immediately 43 revoke the permit of any permittee who violates the provisions of 44 this section.

45 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 46 and after July 1, 2021.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
