Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1383

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the
8	expenses of the Office of State Public Defender of the State of
9	Mississippi for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending
10	June 30, 2022\$ 2,997,795.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
13	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
14	Permanent: Full Time 25
15	Part Time 0
16	Time-Limited: Full Time
17	Part Time 0
18	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
19	the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
20	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
21	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
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22 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 23 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 45 Office of State Public Defender shall maintain complete accounting 46 47 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds H. 48 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 49 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 50 2021. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 51 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2023 shall be submitted to 52 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 53 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 54 during the Fiscal Year 2022 budget request process.

55 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that 56 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 57 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 58 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 59 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 60 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 61 62 made without competitive bids.

63 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 64 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 65 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 66 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 67 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 68 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 69 actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 7. Of the funds provided in Section 1, Two Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$278,500.00) shall be provided for the Indigent Parental Representation for the purpose of contracting with trained and certified attorneys to represent

H. B. 1383 PAGE 3 indigent parents or guardians in abuse, neglect or termination of parental rights proceedings as provided under Sections 43-21-201 and 99-18-13, Mississippi Code of 1972.

77 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 78 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 79 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 80 81 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 82 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 83 84 and after July 1, 2021, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2021.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
