Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1386

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

26 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 27 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2023 do not 28 exceed Fiscal Year 2022 funds appropriated for that purpose unless 29 30 programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2022 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by 31 32 the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 33 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 34 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 35 Absent a special situation or circumstance approved by the act. State Personnel Board, or unless otherwise authorized by this act, 36 37 no state agency shall take any action to promote or otherwise 38 award salary increases through reallocation or realignment. Ιf the State Personnel Board determines a special situation or 39 40 circumstance exists and approves an action, then the agency and 41 the State Personnel Board shall provide a monthly report of each 42 action approved by the State Personnel Board to the chairmen of 43 the Accountability, Efficiency and Transparency Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives and the chairmen of the 44 45 Appropriations Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives. It shall be the responsibility of the agency 46 47 head to ensure that no single personnel action increases this H. B. 1386

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48 projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2022 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of 49 50 escalated funds and the award of benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State 51 52 Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action 53 which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost 54 or the Fiscal Year 2022 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the 55 56 projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be 57 processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the 58 requirements of this provision are met.

59 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 60 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. 61 The State 62 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 63 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 64 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 65 66 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 67 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating H. B. 1386 PAGE 3 74 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as 75 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

76 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 77 Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete 78 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 79 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 80 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 81 Year 2021. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 82 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2023 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 83 84 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 85 provided during the Fiscal Year 2022 budget request process.

SECTION 5. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History.

93 SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 94 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 95 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 96 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

97 SECTION 7. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Two Million 98 Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives 99 and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in H. B. 1386 PAGE 4 House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

102 SECTION 8. Of the funds provided under the provisions of this act, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is provided 103 104 for the purpose of capital development and maintenance of Beauvoir 105 Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only President of 106 the Confederate States of America, subject to approval by the 107 Department of Archives and History. The expenditure of funds 108 available in this section shall be subject to prior approval by 109 the Department of Archives and History.

110 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 111 112 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 113 114 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 115 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 116 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 117 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 10. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Archives and History for the purpose of supporting the Statewide Oral History Project for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022.....\$ 45,748.00.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

132 SECTION 12. Of the funds provided in Section 2, Seven 133 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) is provided from 134 Special Funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section 27-19-56.69(8), Mississippi Code 135 136 of 1972, for the purpose of paying the costs of repair and 137 renovation of the New Capitol, the Old Capitol, the Governor's 138 Mansion, and the War Memorial Building, in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in 139 140 a manner consistent with the escalation of funds.

141 SECTION 13. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital 142 143 Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated for the Department of 144 Archives and History for the purpose of reauthorizing the 145 expenditure of Capital Expense Funds, as authorized in HB 1703, 146 2020 Regular Session to provide for the de la Pointe-Krebs House for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending 147 June 30, 2022.....\$ 651,319.00. 148

H. B. 1386 PAGE 6 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2021.

SECTION 14. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the General Fund not otherwise appropriated for the Department of Archives and History for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of General Funds as authorized in HB 1703, 2020 Regular Session to provide for Beauvoir, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022.....\$ 100,000.00.

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2021.

162 The following sum, or so much thereof as may be SECTION 15. 163 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the BP Settlement 164 Fund not otherwise appropriated for the Department of Archives and 165 History for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of BP 166 Settlement Funds as authorized in SB 2969, 2020 Regular Session to 167 provide for Holmes County historical markers, for the fiscal year 168 beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022.....\$ 10,000.00. 169 170 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the

171 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended 172 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2021.

SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the H. B. 1386

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175 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 176 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 177 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 178 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 179 SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from 180 and after July 1, 2021, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2021.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
