Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1394

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

L2	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

- agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State 51

- 53 which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost
- 54 or the Fiscal Year 2022 "Personal Services" appropriated level,
- when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the 55

- 76 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 77 Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission shall maintain complete
- 78 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 79 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 80 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 81 Year 2021. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 82 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2023 shall be
- 83 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 84 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 85 provided during the Fiscal Year 2022 budget request process.
- 86 **SECTION 5.** It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or
- 87 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of
- 88 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of
- 89 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for
- 90 any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of
- 91 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.
- 92 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles
- 93 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply
- 94 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 95 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 96 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 97 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 98 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 99 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
 made without competitive bids.
- 103 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
 104 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
 105 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
 106 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
 107 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
 108 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
 109 actions contrary to this provision.
- section 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2021, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2021.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE GRAND GULF MILITARY MONUMENT COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022.
