## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill No. 504

# Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. Section 37-17-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:
37-17-3. The Commission on School Accreditation created

9 under this section is hereby continued and reconstituted as 10 follows:

11 The State Board of Education shall appoint a "Commission on 12 School Accreditation" to be composed of fifteen (15) qualified 13 members. The membership of said commission shall be composed of 14 the following: two (2) classroom teachers, two (2) principals of 15 schools, one (1) administrator with expertise in special education

16 representing exceptional schools and students, one (1)

17 superintendent of a separate school district, one (1) superintendent of a county or other school district, one (1) local 18 19 school board member from a separate school district; one (1) local 20 school board member from a county or other school district; 21 and  $\star$   $\star$  six (6) members who are not actively engaged in the 22 education profession. Members of the commission serving on July 23 1, 1994, shall continue to serve until their term of office 24 expires. No new appointments shall be made until such time as the 25 expiration of a member's term has reduced the commission to less 26 than fifteen (15) members, at which time new appointments shall be made from the categories specified hereinabove. The membership of 27 28 said commission shall be appointed by the board upon 29 recommendation of the State Superintendent of Public Education. In making the first appointments, five (5) members shall be 30 31 appointed for a term of one (1) year, five (5) members shall be 32 appointed for a term of two (2) years, five (5) members shall be 33 appointed for a term of three (3) years, and five (5) members 34 shall be appointed for a term of four (4) years. Thereafter, all 35 members shall be appointed for a term of four (4) years. Said 36 commission shall meet upon call of the State Superintendent of 37 Public Education. \* \* \* The commission shall consist of three (3) 38 members  $\star$   $\star$  from each of the four (4) congressional districts, 39 and three (3) members from the state at large. Each member of said commission shall receive the per diem authorized by Section 40

41 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, plus actual and necessary
42 expenses and mileage as authorized by Section 25-3-41, Mississippi
43 Code of 1972, for each day actually spent in attending the
44 meetings of the commission. The expenses of said commission shall
45 be paid out of any funds available for the operation of the
46 <u>central office of the</u> State Department of Education.
47 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

48 and after its passage.

# Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-17-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 CLARIFY THE COMPOSITION OF THE COMMISSION ON SCHOOL ACCREDITATION 3 TO REFLECT THE FOUR CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS AND APPOINTMENT OF 4 THREE MEMBERS FROM THE STATE AT LARGE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
