Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the
8	expenses of the Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel, for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022
10	\$ 1,487,102.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
13	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
14	Permanent: Full Time 9

15	Part Time 0
16	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
17	Part Time 0
18	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
19	the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
20	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
21	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
22	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
23	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
24	SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
25	Office of Capital Post-Conviction Counsel shall maintain complete
26	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
27	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
28	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
29	Year 2021. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
30	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2023 shall be
31	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
32	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
33	provided during the Fiscal Year 2022 budget request process.
34	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
35	Office of Capital Post - Conviction Counsel is hereby authorized
36	to pay invoices submitted by Dr. Robert G. Stanulis, for services
37	in prior fiscal years in an amount not to exceed Twelve Thousand
38	Seventy-five Dollars (\$12,075.00).

- 39 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 40 Office of Capital Post Conviction Counsel is hereby authorized
- 41 to pay invoices submitted by Dr. Robert D. Shaffer, for services
- 42 in prior fiscal years in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty
- 43 Dollars (\$250.00).
- 44 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 45 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 46 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 47 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 48 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 49 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 50 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 51 made without competitive bids.
- 52 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 53 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 54 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 55 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 56 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 57 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 58 actions contrary to this provision.
- 59 **SECTION 8.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 60 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 61 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 62 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal



- 63 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 64
- SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 65
- 66 and after July 1, 2021, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2021.
