2       **Further amend** on line 27 by striking "(a)" and inserting in  
3 lieu thereof, "(i)".

4       **Further amend** on line 29 by striking "(b)" and inserting in  
5 lieu thereof, "(ii)".

6       **Further amend** after line 30, by inserting the following as a  
7 new paragraph:

8               "(b) Any history curriculum adopted by a public  
9 institution of higher learning, community or junior college,  
10 public school district, public school or charter school, shall  
11 include, but not be limited to, the exposure of Mississippi  
12 students, through one or more history studies or curriculum  
13 instruction, to the historical significance, musical contributions  
14 accomplishments, which has garnered Mississippi the title of the  
15 "birthplace of America's music," of such notable Blues legends as:

- 16 (i) B.B. King; Indianola  
17 (ii) Tyrone Davis; Greenville  
18 (iii) Muddy Waters; Issaquena County  
19 (iv) Robert Leroy Johnson; Hazelhurst  
20 (v) Michael Henderson; ~~and~~ Yazoo City  
21 (vi) David Ruffin." and Why not  
22 Jerry Butler Sunflower, Ms
