HOUSE BILL NO. 21

1	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-3-120, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2	TO PROVIDE THAT THE CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION COMMISSION OF THE
3	MISSISSIPPI BAR SHALL AWARD SIX HOURS OF CONTINUING LEGAL
4	EDUCATION CREDIT ANNUALLY TO EACH ATTORNEY WHO CERTIFIES HIS OR
5	HER EMPLOYMENT WITH THE MISSISSIPPI SENATE OR THE HOUSE OF
6	REPRESENTATIVES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 73-3-120, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 10 73-3-120. (1) Members of the bar shall be divided into
- 11 active and inactive membership classes which shall be defined as
- 12 follows:
- 13 (a) "Active member" means any person admitted to
- 14 practice law in this state and who is engaged in the practice of
- 15 law in this state. Except as otherwise provided in Section
- 16 73-3-125, all active members shall be entitled to vote and hold
- 17 office in the bar.
- 18 (b) "Inactive member" means any member, in good

- 19 standing, who is not engaged in the practice of law in this state.
- 20 A person may, upon written request, be enrolled as an inactive

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21	member.	Inactive	members	shall	not	be	entitled	to	vote	and	hold

- 22 office in the bar.
- 23 (2) As used in this section, the "practice of law" shall
- 24 include any person holding himself out as a practicing attorney or
- 25 occupying any position in which he may be called upon to give
- 26 legal advice or counsel or to examine the law or to pass upon the
- 27 legal effect of any act, document or law.
- 28 (3) (a) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
- 29 the Mississippi Bar shall promulgate rules and regulations
- 30 regarding continuing legal education requirements between active
- 31 and inactive status.
- 32 (b) The Continuing Legal Education Commission of the
- 33 Mississippi Bar shall award six (6) hours of continuing legal
- 34 education credit annually to each attorney who certifies his or
- 35 her employment with the Mississippi Senate or the House of
- 36 Representatives. The commission shall provide the certification
- 37 f<u>orm.</u>
- 38 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 39 and after July 1, 2022.
