- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** The owner of a retail business at a fixed
- 9 permanent location that accepts the use of credit cards or debit
- 10 cards for payment for the goods or services sold by the business
- 11 shall have video cameras or similar visual recording devices
- 12 located at or near the card processing equipment to record the
- 13 persons who use the credit or debit cards with that equipment.
- 14 The owner shall maintain the recordings of the persons using
- 15 credit or debit cards for not less than six (6) months for access
- 16 by law enforcement personnel.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2022.
